Senqu Municipality Supply Chain Management Policy as well as the following conditions shall apply:

- Canvassing of municipal staff or councillors will automatically disqualify any tender.
- The tender must be bound with own documents and all SCM documents and tender advertisement.
- The tender must be bound with the tender bidding checklist as the first page of the document with the completed page numbers.
- A current Tender Tax Clearance Certificate (original) must be supplied with the tender or else the tender will not be considered.
- All prices must include VAT.
- The municipal rates and taxes or municipal charges owed by the preferred bidder or any of its directors, to the municipality or municipal entity, or to any other municipality or its entity, must not be in arrears for more than three months. Proof must be submitted in the form of a recent municipal account or letter of good standing.
- If a municipal account is not available, a copy of the lease contract with the confirmation from the Owner of the property that confirms in writing that the rental is paid up to date.

- The successful bidder will be required to register on the Senqu Municipality data base.
- Prices must be valid for a minimum period of 120 days.
- The tenders will be evaluated on the 80/20 preference points system as prescribed in the PPPFA; these documents will be available on the Senqu Municipality website – [www.sengumunicipality.co.za](http://www.sengumunicipality.co.za)
- Preferential Procurement Regulation 2017 (B-BBEE) principles will apply, whereby a tenderer's submission will be evaluated according to the sum of the Award of Points in respect of the tender value and the status of the enterprise
  - Adjudication criteria are as follows:
    - 80 Points for Price
    - 20 Points for B-BBEE status level of Contribution

Points must be awarded to a bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table below:

### **SPECIFICATIONS AND INFORMATION**

1. Tender Price must be an all-inclusive lump sum price: i.e., Design, Tender documents, Contract administration, site supervision and be valid for 120 days.
2. Allowance of R20 000 must be added for PSC training and R 50 000 for credited training which is included in the project business plan.
3. Road surface must be paved with the base layer of 300 mm, 20mm sand and 80mm SABS approved brick pavers and stone pitched storm-water channels.
4. Width of roads must be 6 meter excluding storm water channels of 1m wide.
5. Design must include storm water drainage and the transfer thereof to acceptable disposal areas.
6. A descriptive design report with estimated cost of construction must accompany the tender document.
7. Payments to consultants must be specified at which stage and the amounts to be paid.
8. Consultants must draw up and bind their own documents at their costs.
9. Site supervision must be a minimum of three days a week.
10. Site staff must be qualified in this field and have a minimum of three year experience.
11. Proof of registration as a professional consultant must accompany the tender document.
12. Estimated period must accompany the tender for the construction of the above.
13. Bidders are required to submit together with their bids a valid BBBEE status level verification certificate.
14. Bidders must visit the sites by themselves as per the drawings and co-ordinates supplied.
15. Design, document and supervise construction of 6km paved road with storm-water channels report should include company previous experience with reference, permanently employed Professional Engineer, full scope of works and prepare as built drawings

Designs must consider the following:-

16. Use of labour intensive method by employing SMME with CIDB 1 CE PE or and 2 CE PE.
17. The bill of quantity should include 30% SMME contract value.
18. Consultant to liaise with the ISD officer and Skills Development Facilitator to identify beneficiaries to be formally trained on identified program that will have a positive impact on the beneficiaries.
19. Estimated maintenance period which will include long term consideration and climate
20. Cost estimate of construction
21. SANS 10495 guidelines to be used.
22. The consultant will be expected to draw up the tender documents for 6km construction of paved roads with storm-water channels which will be approved by the client.
23. The consultant will supervise and ensure project management of the Works at all times, until completion.
24. Site meetings will be held monthly or as required by the client.
25. A PSC must be established with seating allowances for non- government attendees (4)
26. There will be a resident site engineer/representative at all times, until completion.
27. The consultant shall ensure maximum local labour use as per EPWP guidelines.
28. The consultant shall ensure final "as build" drawings and Bill of Quantities.(Soft & Hard copy in editable version)
29. The consultant **will** be required to enter into a performance SLA with the municipality or the tender **will be considered non-responsive**.
30. The consultant will ensure all legislative requirements are met during the contract period (safety etc.).
