Tenders are hereby invited for eligible contractors with a valid Eskom registration and CIDB grading designation of at least 5EP respectively for wards 2 and 3.

A Compulsory Site Inspection meeting with representatives of the Engineer will take place at the municipal offices of Senqu Municipality, 19 Murray Street, LADY GREY on 02 November 2017 starting at 10:00 am. Tender documents will be made available at Senqu Municipality Office during working hours and is available from the 30th of October 2017 at a non-refundable tender deposit of R 500 .00 payable in cash or by bank guaranteed cheque made out in favour of Senqu Municipality. At the compulsory site inspection meeting Proof of payment is required on collection of the tender documents.

At least one representative of a company must attend the meeting and is it not allowed that this particular representative represent other companies that he/she does not have an interest in. Should two or more companies intend to tender in a Joint Venture, both such companies must be represented.

Sealed tenders clearly marked: **TENDER NOTICE NUMBER 134/2017 CONSTRUCTION OF ELECTRIFICATION OF RURAL CONNECTIONS** must be placed in the tender box at the office of Senqu Municipality in Lady Grey. Postal delivery to reach Senqu Municipality, PO Box 18, Lady Grey, 9755, **not later than 12h00 on Friday 17th November 2017**, after which the tenders will be opened in public. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late tenders will not be accepted.

The Senqu Municipality Supply Chain Management Policy as well as the following conditions shall apply:

- Canvassing of municipal staff or councillors will automatically disqualify any tender.
- The tender must be bound with own documents and all SCM documents and tender advertisement.
- A current Tax Clearance Certificate (original) must be supplied with the tender or else the tender will not be considered.
- All prices must include VAT.
- The municipal rates and taxes or municipal charges owed by the preferred bidder or any of its directors, to the municipality or municipal entity, or to any other municipality or its entity, must not be in arrears for more than three months. Proof must be submitted in the form of a recent municipal account or letter of good standing.
- Proof of registration as Eskom approved contractor a requirement. Proof to be submitted with tender documentation. Failure to comply will lead to disqualification.
- Proof of registration at the CIDB, with a minimum rating of 5EP, must accompany the completed tender document. If not so, the tender will not be considered.
- The successful bidder will be required to register on the Senqu Municipality data base.
- Prices must be valid for a minimum OF 120 days.

- The tenders will be evaluated on the 80/20 preference points system as prescribed in the PPPFA; these documents will be available on the Senqu Municipality website – www.sengumunicipality.co.za
- Preferential Procurement Regulation 2017 (B-BBEE) principles will apply, whereby a tenderer's submission will be evaluated according to the sum of the Award of Points in respect of the tender value and the status of the enterprise
- 30% of contract amount must be must utilized for local emerging contractors and expenditure reported on monthly on EPWP specifications.
 - ❑ Adjudication criteria are as follows:
 - ❑ 80 Points for Price
 - ❑ 20 Points for B-BBEE status level of Contribution

Points must be awarded to a bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table below:

- The Senqu Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves the right to accept the whole or part of any bid.
- No emailed or faxed documents will be accepted.
- Submission of an original B-BBEE Verification Certificate or certified copy.
- A trust, consortium or joint venture must obtain and submit a consolidate B-BBEE status Verification Certificate with the tender and consolidated CIDB grading.
- Bids which are late, incomplete, unsigned will not be accepted including couriered documents
- The following Municipal Bid Documents are compulsory documents and must be included in the tender document:

 - Signed Specifications (Terms of reference)
 - **MBD 1(Compulsory) to be completed and signed for ward 2 and 3 separately Vat Inclusive.**

 - MBD 4(Compulsory for all shareholders and or directors.)
 - MBD 6.1(Compulsory)
 - MBD 6.2(Compulsory) 90% for all purchasing of cables must be local content with valid proof thereof.
 - MBD 7.1(Compulsory)
 - MBD 8(Compulsory)
 - MBD 9(Compulsory)
 - CSD Registration Supplier Summary Report(Compulsory)
 - **Eskom contractor registration(Compulsory)**
 - CIDB contractor registration(Compulsory)

- Failure to complete all supplementary information and the RETURNABLE SCHEDULES including requested MBD Forms as well as submitting all relevant registrations will result in the tender being disqualified.
