Senqu Local Municipality wishes to invite quotations from suitably qualified service providers to conduct an employee satisfaction survey for the 2017/18 financial year.

The closing date for submission of applications is at **12h00** on **12 June 2018** and applications must be placed in sealed envelopes and clearly marked "Employee Satisfaction Survey" – **Notice No: 105/2017/2018"** and delivered to the offices of the Municipality at 19 Murray Street, Lady Grey and placed in the tender box.

- 1. The Municipality requires services of suitably qualified service providers to conduct the above survey.
- 2. The proposals to be submitted to the Municipality must include the following:
 - 2.1 A profile of the bidder 's organisation
 - 2.2 The details of directors and certified copies of the IDs;
 - 2.3 The details of the practitioners who will conduct the survey, their qualifications, proof of professional registration (where applicable), experience (in years), *curricula vitae* and traceable references.

- 2.4 Bidders are requested to fully outline their methodology in their proposals.
- 2.5 The survey will be conducted on a yearly basis. Bidders are requested to a pricing schedule for 270 employees based on face to face interactions.
- 2.6 Details of the geographic location of the organisation and the office infrastructure supporting the organisation including lease agreement and / or title deed:
- 1.1 An original valid Tender Tax Clearance Certificate or the SARS PIN must be supplied with the tender or else the tender will not be considered;
- 1.2 Central Supplier Database registration number must be submitted for verification, all information submitted will be verified with the Central Data Base;
- 1.3 Certified copy of the applicant's Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Status Level Certificate, valid as at the date of submission; any misrepresentation in terms of the above constitutes a criminal offences as set out in the BBBEE Act.
- 1.4 Applicants who qualify as Exempted Micro Enterprises (EMEs) in terms of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, must submit a certified copy of its certificate issued by a registered auditor, or an accredited verification agency, with the copies of the active members.
- 1.5 Current Municipal Billing Clearance Certificate. No contract will be awarded to an applicant who is in arrears (or who fails to make suitable arrangements to settle the arrears) in respect of municipal rates and other charges due to the Municipality or the municipality in whose jurisdiction its offices are located, please submit a letter of good standing from your municipality as registered on CSD., OR your latest municipal account.

- 1.7 The service provider will be required to register in the Municipal database;

- b) MBD 1 (Invitations to bid)
- c) MBD3.1 (Pricing schedule)
- d) MBD 4 (Declaration of Interest)
- e) MBD 6.1 (Preference points claim form)
- f) MBD 7.2 (Contract form Rendering of services)
- g) MBD 8 (Declaration of Bidder's past supply chain management practices)
- h) MBD 9 (Certificate of independent bid determination)

Failure to complete all supplementary information and the RETURNABLE SCHEDULES including requested MBD Forms not completed in full and not signed will result in the tender being disqualified. The municipality reserves the right to request minor documents from responsive bidders which will not have an impact on the final award of the tender.

4 The evaluation of submissions shall be subject to the following criteria and only applicants scoring a minimum of 80 points will then be evaluated on BBBEE points and price and then be considered for appointment. For functionality, bidders shall be awarded one set of points in each category in line with their relevant experience, expertise and verifiable references.
