- All prices must include VAT.
- The municipal rates and taxes or municipal charges owed by the preferred bidder or any of its directors, to the municipality or municipal entity, or to any other municipality or its entity, must not be in arrears for more than three months. - The tenderer must sign and tick the specifications in order to be considered, if the tenderer did not tick and sign to acknowledge the specs the tender will be
- All requirements must be met in order for the Tender Document to be considered.
