SENQU MUNICIPALITY CONDEMN VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN

The onslaught of violence against women remains a persistent threat as seen in the murder of three women in Dulcinesek in Sterskpruit, who were shot dead and a fourth is in hospital in a critical condition.

The Mayor of Senqu Local Municipality, Nomvuyo Mposelwa, together with Councillors and Traditional Leaders visited the village and the families of the women today in mourning the untimely and violent end to their lives.

Tragically, violence inflicted on women and children is among the countless number of other women who are victims of gender based violence, yet they remain unnamed.

The Senqu Local Municipality will continue to call on all facets of society to urgently bring the violence against women and children to an end and further calls on the relevant authorities to ensure that we provide greater safety for women everywhere, in our homes, places of work and other public spaces.

It cannot be that South Africa we know with its's entrenched spirit of Ubuntu is becoming an unsafe habitat for women and children. South Africans must unite in the fight against Gender-Based Violence
